I have started to mow the field, but not all of it due to the ground being a bit too wet, but as it starts to dry out I will complete it.


Would the people who leave planes in the bin please burn them or take them home thanks (or give them to Hardy Maxamiser – ed...)


And, we have Matt Carter back on the team as assistant competition director.


A wanted section has been added to the WPMAC web site clasifieds.

So if there's anything you need or want, just make an ad. A suggestion though - rather than post a list,




